To make the learning process appealing a combination of various modes of teaching was applied including Class room teaching, case studies and trading game.

The Faculties were drawn from Industry as well as academia so as to share the experience and learning from best of both the worlds. Apart from learning activities, the participants were also taken for recreation to Golconda sound and light show on day two.
